Re: Buy American Compliance

All of the toilet partitions and lockers made and sold by Scranton Products are manufactured in the USA and are considered domestic products under the Buy American Act (the "BAA").

All plastic HDPE components are made from raw material purchased within the United States and extruded in Scranton, Pennsylvania. The only components sourced outside of the United States are certain hardware components. We source certain hardware outside of the United States because American Made hardware for bathroom partitions is not readily available.

The BAA, as implemented in Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Part 25, requires that to qualify as a domestic end product, manufactured end products must be 1) manufactured in the United States; and 2) the cost of domestic components exceed a certain percentage of the cost of all components. The applicable percentage currently in effect is 65%.

Scranton Products orders contain HDPE plastic components, which are domestic components, and hardware, which contains certain foreign components. The cost of the HDPE plastic components exceeds more than 65% of all components.

Because the cost of the domestic components exceeds more than 65% of all components, our toilet partitions and lockers are domestic products under the BAA.
